At Anderson Humane Society, we rely on our volunteers to help keep our adoption center clean and our animals fed on the days that our staff is off. This includes every weekend (Saturday and Sunday) and all major holidays. Please select the day that you are interested in volunteering with us. As always, we are extremely grateful for your help and continued support! Thank you!

Saturdays: The Adoption Center is open from 10am-12pm. Volunteers should meet at the Adoption Center by 10 am; one person will have codes. Contact Donna Callahan at 502-600-2106 if you have any issues.

Sundays: The Adoption Center is NOT open to the public. Volunteers should meet at the gate no later than 9 am, or another other time agreed upon by volunteers; one person will have codes. Contact Donna Callahan at 502-600-2106 if you have any issues.

Holidays: The adoption center is NOT open to the public. Volunteers should meet at the gate no later than 9 am, or another other time agreed upon by volunteers; one person will have codes. Contact Donna Callahan at 502-600-2106 if you have any issues.

Following is a list of duties for each day:

Dogs-Let dogs out for exercise, clean kennels, replace bedding, wash water and food bowls and replace with fresh water and food. Wash bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Give dogs extra attention and spoiling before leaving them for the day.

Cats-Scoop and/or change litter box, if changing litter box, wash litter box and replace with fresh pan. Wash water bowls and replace with fresh water and food. Spray and wipe down inside of cat housing. Wash bedding and replace with fresh bedding. Give cats/kittens extra attention and spoiling before leaving them for the day.

General-Wash food/water dishes, wash laundry (cat/dog bedding), mop floors in front rooms.

January Board Meeting

The Anderson Humane Society Board held an organizational meeting on Saturday, January 11, 2020.

Some important information from the meeting:

- 1. Board/Membership Meetings
- Meetings will be conducted following Roberts Rules of Order
- Board Meetings will be held the first Tuesday of every month from 5:15-6:30
- Membership meetings will be held the first Tuesday of every month from 6:30-7:30
- Meetings will be held at the Library, unless otherwise notified
- 2. Membership Committee –This committee, chaired by Paula Thomson, is working to increase the Humane Society's membership. They are letting the community know the care the Humane Society provides the animals and the benefits of membership through an advertisement in the local newspaper and a mass mailing.
- 3. Advisory Board
- The Advisory Board will be independent of the Humane Society Board.
- The Advisory Board will advise the Humane Society Board in areas to include fundraising, corporate sponsors, and other areas to be determined
- The selection of members to serve on this Board is currently in process
- 4. Legacy Committee –This is a new committee established by the Board. This committee will seek ways to inform individuals of the opportunities they can consider to leave a legacy with the Anderson Humane Society. Committee members Karine Maynard, Ann Chilton, Donna Callahan and Lisa Petrey-Kirk.
- 5. By-Laws Committee This committee was formed to review our current by-laws. Sally Higgins is leading this committee.
- 6. Adoption Center Improvements Doug Stockton reported on plans to lower the ceiling in the dog kennel area to assist in maintaining a favorable temperature throughout the year. Doug also reported on methods to improve the water issues at the front door of the Adoption Center. The Board approved the cost Doug provided on these projects.
