News from the Adoption Center

Donna and crew were busy in February taking in and caring for dogs and cats.

Cats

- Fifteen cats came to the Adoption Center. Four from Mercer Co.
- Twenty-one cats were adopted or rescued
- Four are in foster care
- Two are at the Adoption Center

Dogs

- Eight dogs came to the Adoption Center
- Twelve were adopted or rescued
- One was returned to the owner
- Three are at the Adoption Center

With fewer pets currently at the Adoption Center and just ahead of kitten season, the lobby and kitten area are getting a fresh coat of bright and cheerful paint. In addition to paint, a protective covering is being placed on the lower portion of the walls to protect against cat/kitten shenanigans!!

The dog kennel has new cabinets and a table for food prep.

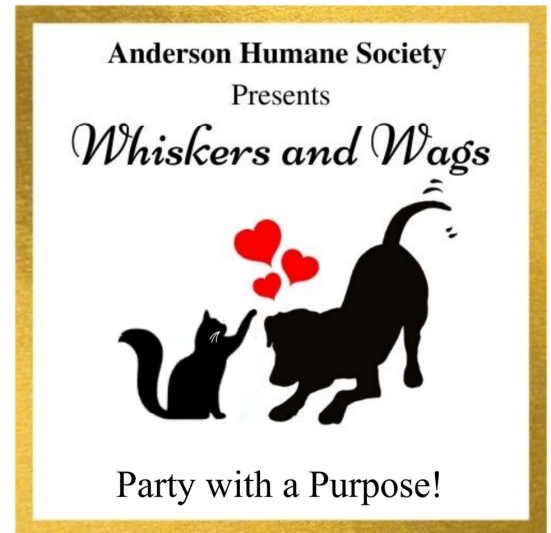

DOG THEFTS ARE MASSIVELY ON THE RISE!

PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE YOUR DOG UNATTENDED AT ANY TIME!

THIEVES ARE:

- WATCHING PUBLIC AREAS WAITING FOR THE OPPORTUNITY TO STEAL YOUR DOG

EVERY DOG HAS A VALUE WHETHER IT BE FOR RESALE, RANSOM, BREEDING OR BAITING!



REMEMBER:

- NEVER LEAVE YOUR DOG OUTSIDE ALONE, EVEN ON YOUR OWN PROPERTY
- DO NOT LET YOUNG CHILDREN WALK YOUR DOG
- IF YOU KNOW AN ELDERLY PERSON WHO HAS A DOG PLEASE TRY TO WALK WITH THEM
- MAKE SURE YOUR DOG IS MICROCHIPPED AND THE DETAILS ARE UP TO DATE
HOWEVER A MICROCHIP WILL NOT GUARANTEE YOUR DOG'S SAFE RETURN IF STOLEN, SO THEFT PREVENTION IS KEY!

WE NEED TO FIGHT BACK AGAINST THESE THIEVES AND MAKE DOG THEFT AS DIFFICULT AS POSSIBLE FOR THEM.

PLEASE DO NOT LET IT BE YOUR BELOVED PET THAT GETS TAKEN.
