We are excited about upcoming changes in the dog kennel area at the adoption center!! By removing a wall and adding faucets and hot water, we will be able to add a bathing station!!! We are very excited about this renovation!!

Duties include letting dogs out to appropriate play yards, scooping kennels of debris, gathering blankets, rugs, toys and food dishes for washing. Spray disinfectant, rinse, squeegee dry. Replace with clean dry blankets, fresh food and water and bring dogs back in.

Cats cages need to be swept out and sprayed with disinfectant, litter boxes scooped, food and water freshened and any soiled blankets or toys replaced.


Supply Drives
